#### **EUROPEAN JUNIOR CUP COMPETITION 2010**

The Junior Cup competition will be held in Reggio Calabria on 18-23 May and will be also the Continental Quota Tournament (CQT) for the first Youth Olympic Games in Singapore 2010.

Competition: Ranking Round – 70m/60m Round; Olympic Round (with set system only for Individual)

**CQT**: 2x70m + Olympic Round with set system

#### RULES OF THE EUROPEAN JUNIOR CUP COMPETITIONS

- 1 The European Junior (and Cadet) Cup competitions are organized in accordance with FITA Constitution and Rules (FITA C&R).
- **2** European Junior Cup competitions General Format:
- 2.1 There will be:
  - One leg of the European Junior Cup and Junior Cup Final at the European and Mediterranean Junior Archery Championships in even years;
  - One leg of the European Junior Cup and Junior Cup Final in odd years (when FITA World Junior Archery Championships is organized).
- **2.2 Daily Schedule of the European Junior Cup competitions** (including official training day, last day of the competition Saturday) will be prepared by the organizers together with the appointed Technical Delegate:

Ranking Round – FITA Round – 5 days: Tuesday – Saturday Ranking Round – 70m/60m Round – 4 days: Wednesday - Saturday
```

The finals will be shot, according to the new FITA rules, with set system

### 2.3 Allocation of European Junior Cup competitions

- 2.3.1 Any organization willing to host Junior Cup event according to EMAU requirements can submit a bid to EMAU Secretary General through the Member Association (MA) of the country in which the Junior Cup event will take place.
- 2.3.2 The bid must be submitted before June 30th of the year previous to the year of event. The application form has to be sent to the EMAU Secretary General together with the Bid/Evaluation checklist for Junior events.

2.3.3 The international competition calendar and the school calendar inEurope have to be taken into account. However Junior Cup tournaments should be organized:

1<sup>st</sup> leg around the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of May 2<sup>nd</sup> leg around the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July

- 2.3.4 The Calendar of Junior Cup competitions for each year will be approved by EMAU Council and published at the official web site. (Appendix 1)
- **2.4 Disciplines** (FITA C&R art. 4.1)
- 2.4.1 The European Junior Cup competitions are organized in the discipline of Outdoor Target Archery.
- **2.5** Classes admitted FITA C&R art. 4.2 be aware of age changes in FITA Rules as from 1 1 2010
  - Cadet Women
  - Cadet Men
  - Junior Women
  - Junior Men
- **2.6 Divisions admitted** (FITA C&R art. 4.3)
  - Recurve Division with equipment as specified in FITA C&R art. 7.3.1:
  - Compound Division with equipment as specified in FITA C&R art. 7.3.3.
- 2.7 Number of participants:

The number of athletes that may be entered by a MA is limited to four (4)/category.

- 2.8 All FITA MAs are eligible to compete in European Junior Cup competitions, but only the results of the athletes from EMAU MA's will be taken for the Junior Cup Circuit.
- 2.9 Rounds shot at European Junior Cup competitions

Outdoor Target archery rounds (according to FITA C&R art. 4.5.1)

- 2.9.1 The FITA Outdoor Target Archery Round (according to FITA C&R 4.5.1.2) will be shot in odd years;
- 2.9.2 The FITA 60 Meter Round (according to FITA C&R art. 4.5.1.6) and the FITA 70 Meter Round (according to FITA C&R art. 4.5.1.7) will be shot in even years.
- 3 Application of FITA rules at European Junior Cup competitions
- 3.1 The Outdoor Target Archery rules will comply with those of FITA, which are in force in the year of the organisation of the European Junior Cup competition.

- 3.2 The articles of the FITA rules below are applied at Junior Cup competitions with following exceptions:
- 3.2.1 The maximum of 64 archers per category will qualify for the Olympic Round Individual event.
- 3.2.2 Archers both in the individual and team Final rounds may continue to score and collect their arrows also when they are shooting alternating.
- 3.2.3 The quarter and semi-finals matches may be shot not alternating.
- 3.2.4 The final matches for the Bronze and Gold Medals will follow the FITA ruling of alternate shooting. At this stage of the event two targets will be utilised for each match (i.e. one archer per target).
- 3.2.5 If the time frame of the competition doesn't allow to fit the required number of alternated matches, the matches can be combined. A sufficient number judges will be provided, who will lead the matches using stopwatches
- 3.2.6 All bronze medal matches may be shot at the same time.
- 3.2.7 All Cadet gold medal matches may be shot at the same time
- 3.2.8 All Junior gold medal matches may be shot at the same time.
- 3.3 Team competitions
- 3.3.1 When the MA will enter 4 athletes in one category, the team will consist of three (3) athletes only. All members of a team must be announced prior to the start of the Qualification Round. Such members must take part in the Qualification Round and cannot be changed.

#### 4. Results

The results must be done according to EMAU results system (IANSEO). The daily results must also be placed on the Website created by the organizer and be made available to EMAU Website

#### 5 Awards at European Junior Cup competitions:

- 5.1 The top 3 placed individuals and teams in each division and in each class in Olympic rounds in each leg of the European Junior Cup competition will receive awards as the winners of that tournament.
- 5.2 The awards at the European Junior Cup competitions will be provided by the Organizing Committee (8x3 for individuals and 24x3 for teams).

- 5.3 At the Awards Ceremony the Anthem of the Individual and Team winner's country will be played, the flags of the top three placed individuals' and teams' countries will be raised.
- 6. Determining the winners of the European Junior Cup circuit:
- 6.1 Determining the winners in the Individual competition
- 6.1.1 The winner, the second and the third placed archers in each category of the European Junior Cup Circuit are determined among the EMAU athletes and teams by the highest total score of two Qualification rounds results.

### 6.2 Determining the winners in the Team competition

- 6.2.1 The placement of each MA in the Team Olympic round in each category in the two legs, will be taken into account.For each MA and each category, the number of points from the two legs will be added. No finals will be shot if less than 4 teams are participating in a category. In that case the teams will be ranked according the Qualification Round and no points
- 6.2.2 The following points are being given at each leg for teams placed:

1<sup>st</sup> place 10 points 2<sup>nd</sup> place 8 points 3<sup>rd</sup> place 4 points 4<sup>th</sup> place 2 points

- 6.2.3 In the case of a tie, the highest number of first places, second places etc. will decide the winner. If there is still a tie, the highest team score in the Qualification Round of the Final of the Cup, whatever category, will determine the winner.
- 6.3 The medals for the final ranking of European Junior Cup circuit for the top 3 individuals in each category will be provided by EMAU.
- 6.4 The cups for the final ranking of European Junior Cup circuit for the top 3 MAs will be provided by the host organizing committee.
- 6.5 The medals and cups are to be engraved by the Organiser with the name and the year of the competition and the place (e.g. "EUROPEAN JUNIOR CUP 200X  $1^{st}$  place/ $2^{nd}$  place/ $3^{rd}$  place").

### 7 Technical Officials

will be given.

7.1 EMAU Council will appoint a Technical Delegate and two (2) International Judges for each tournament.

- 7.2 The organizing MA will provide at least 7 Judges and a Director of Shooting who have not lower than National Judge status. The organizing MA may invite Judges from other MAs.
- 7.3 The Jury of Appeal will be appointed on the field by the Technical Delegate: a chairman and 2 members as well as 2 alternates.

### 8 Entry fee and accommodation

- 8.1 The Organizing Committee will offer sufficient number of rooms. The price should be done not more than **EURO 65** (or equivalent) **per person per day** including full board (the price in double rooms).
- 8.2 The Entry Fee should not exceed **EURO 50 per archer**.
- 8.3 There will be no entry fees for officials and no entry fees for teams.

# **9** EMAU support for Member Associations

9.1 EMAU MAs which have not participated in any of the European Junior Cup competitions until now may apply to EMAU for a grant to enable one archer and one coach to compete. The grant will be awarded upon the decision of EMAU Council.

#### 10 Annual awards for team officials

The European Junior Development Committee will elect every year among the team captains/coaches one team captain/coach and will award him/her. The Team Captain/Coach of the year will be awarded at the Final leg with the diploma and a framed photograph with the writing on it:

Team Captain/Coach of the year 200X

European Junior Cup Competition Rules were ratified by EMAU Council on November 6 th 2009.
