



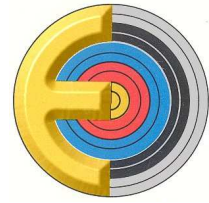

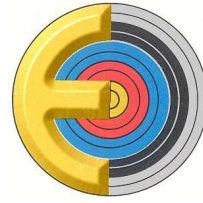

# POINTS to clarify

## 3) Technical Aspects of the competition

### 3.1. Training Facilities & Schedule

The practice field (100 m from the FOP) will be available and operational on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> April until Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> April. It will be open from 8:00 to 18:00h.

### 3.2. Number of Participants per class – (Will be given during the TC meeting)

### 3.3. Competition preliminary Program (attached)

The latest competition program is shown at the end of this TC document. The final program will be handed out at the TC-Meeting. Please check regularly in the Team boxes and public information boards to be aware of any possible changes on the program.

### 3.4. Official Practice & Warm-Up:

- Official Practice (3 hours) on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April from 14:00 to 17:00, for all athletes (abc one detail)
- Qualification Round (30 minutes practice before the Competition).
- Individual and Team Elimination Round Practice (30 minutes before the competition)
- Individual Finals Rounds and Medal Matches Practice (1 hour before the competition, next to the finals FOP)

### 3.5. Equipment Inspection.

Equipment inspection will be run during the official practice on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April. Each team will be called in alphabetical order by the DoS. The inspection will take place at the entry of the competition field. All team members must wear their team uniform, including officials. Also all spare equipment must be brought to the equipment inspection.

### 3.6. Qualification Round and information on scoring

The target assignment will be handed out latest at the Team Captains Meeting.



Qualification Round, on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> April, for all disciplines, shooting 3 athletes per target, ABC one detail.

The athletes will find an electronic score terminal (PDA terminal) at each target. In addition, in the qualification and elimination/finals rounds there will be also one paper score sheet per target, which must be filled in by the athletes themselves. For each target one athlete will enter the score in the paper score sheet; another athlete will score on the PDA terminal. **All the athletes on the same target must verify that the correct scores are entered in the scorecard (this is the valid score following FITA's rules, and then double check that the scores on the scorecards and in the PDA terminal are the same).**

Please instruct your athletes to sign and totally complete the score sheets before handing them back to the Organizing Committee after each round.

### **3.7. Individual Elimination and Finals Round, Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> April.**

Individual Elimination Round, on 16<sup>th</sup> April, at 9:30 for CW and RM, then at 14:00 for CM and RW.

The individual Elimination Round will start with the 1/32, going through to the Quarter finals, per class and division.

Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, athletes will be allowed to shoot on their own target, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.

### **3.8. Team Elimination and Finals Round, Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April.**

Team Elimination Round, on 17<sup>th</sup> April, at 9:00 starting with the 1/8 eliminations until the gold finals for all categories.

Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, Teams will be allowed to shoot on their own target, but no score will be recorded.

**Simultaneous shooting from 1/8 to bronze finals. Alternate for gold medal matches.**

### **3.9. Individual Finals Round, Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> April (1/2 & Medal matches).**

Morning : semi finals will take place in the morning on the FoP. They will start with the Compound women at 10:00, then with the Compound Men, after that the Recurve Women and then the Recurve Men. **Simultaneous shooting for semi finals.**

Practice for competing archers will start at 9:00 am in the morning and 12:00 in the afternoon on the practice area near the finals matches area .

Afternoon : we will have "Live TV" for all the medal matches in the afternoon.

Beginning at 13:00 with the bronze medal matches, first CW, then CM, then RW, then RM, followed directly by the gold medal matches in the same order.

**Alternate shooting for all medal matches.** (see program on page 15.)

### **3.10. Appeal Procedure (Form attached)**

Appeal form is attached to this document – see page 17.

To lodge an intention to appeal or an actual Appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form must be followed.

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission. A deposit of **Euro 40€** must be paid to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the Appeal to be valid.

If the Appeal upheld by the Jury of Appeal, the money will be returned. If the appeal is not successful, the money is retained.

## **4) Technical Matters**

### **4.1. Timing Control system.**

The Chronotir Timing system and the FFTA equipment will be used for Timing and scoreboards.

### **4.2. Results system.**

The scoring in the qualification round will be done by the athletes. One athlete will write down the score on the paper score sheet and another will score on a terminal. The other athletes verify that the correct scores are entered.

During the Equipment Inspection your athletes will be asked to test the terminals to see if they understand the correct working of the terminals.

Daily results are available each day after each competition day at the results manager printed out or on a memory stick.

### **4.3. Rules that apply in this event. EMAU rules.**

- For the Team members' nomination, see the form attached to this document page 16.
- Following EMAU rules, all teams that have more than 3 archers registered in one division, are requested to give in writing to the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission at least one hour before the Qualification Round starts, the names of the 3 athletes who will compete in the team event (for team qualification, Elimination Round and Finals). No substitution will be allowed after the names are given on the form. If a team has failed to give this information one hour before the Qualification Round starts, the 3 athletes with the lowest scores in the Qualification Round will be chosen as

members of this team for the team ranking round, elimination & finals round.

- All athletes will go to the individual elimination rounds after the qualification round.

After this event, the EMAU circuit ranking ([www.emau.org](http://www.emau.org)) and the FITA World ranking ([www.archery.org](http://www.archery.org)) will be updated.

#### **4.4. Price Money:**

**Price Money will be given by the OC to the 3 winners in the individual competition in each division & each category:**

**1<sup>st</sup>: 300€ -**

**2<sup>nd</sup>: 200€ -**

**3<sup>rd</sup>: 100€ -**

#### **4.5. Music during the competition**

The volume level will still allow for coaches to communicate with their archers and should not be a disturbing factor but rather assist the archers.

### **5) Important Rules (changes and FITA Committee official interpretations).**

#### **5.1. Number of arrows / ends to be shot during Elimination**

For 1/32 to 1/8 eliminations, 2 ends of 6 arrows will be shot.

For ¼ finals to Medal matches, 4 ends of 3 arrows will be shot.

Alternate shooting will be used for semi finals and Medal matches to be shot on the finals field Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> April. From 1/32 to 1/16<sup>th</sup> finals we will have 2 athletes per target. One athlete per target from 1/8 to gold.

#### **5.2. Team round procedure. (Clarification of the Shot off for Teams)**

For 1/8 to bronze finals, simultaneous shooting will be used for the team matches. The gold medal matches will be alternate shooting. If a shoot off occurs in the alternates shooting medal matches, the procedure is as follow:

(Rule clarification)

In Team Match play competition when alternate shooting is used, during the tiebreak the team that started the match will shoot all three arrows (one arrow per member) in succession and then the 2nd team will shoot their 3 arrows (one arrow per team member).

#### **5.3. Score card signature.**

Following FITA rules, each scorecard needs to be correctly filled in and signed by the athlete. The athlete is responsible for the total value and each arrow value. If the scorecard is not signed, the result of this athlete may be not

recorded and the athlete could have ZERO points. It is very important to make sure that all scorecards are CORRECTLY completed:

- All arrow values.
- All sums required in the scorecard (Total score, number of 10s. included Xs, and number of Xs.
- The signature of the archer and the scorer.

#### **5.4. Lost arrows.**

As soon as possible, the Team Captains and/or athletes are invited to report to the Tournament Judge Commission each arrow lost from the official Practice time until the end of the competition. The DoS will administer this list. See form to be filled in at page 24.

### **6) Logistical Aspects**

#### **6.1. Transportation:**

Check the schedule in the official hotels and at the competition field for daily transport, between the hotels and the competition area and return.

#### **6.2. Meals:**

Breakfasts and Dinners will be served only at the official hotels according to this schedule;

Breakfast: 06:30 to 09:00 h

Dinner: 19:00 to 21:00 h

The lunches are only served by the OC at the "Archery center" near the FOP from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> April to Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> April. From 12:00 to 14:30.

If you want to have a lunch on another place or out of these dates, you have to do it at your own expenses.

During the meals in the hotels & at the archery centre, water will be served free of charge. If you want other drinks, you must do it at your own expenses.

#### **6.3. Team boxes:**

The team boxes are located at the main entry in the building "Regional Archery Center" at the reception desk.

**7) Protocol and ceremonies****7.1. Opening and closing Ceremonies.**

There is no official opening or closing Ceremonies. Competition will start with official training on April 14<sup>th</sup>.

However we will have a welcome drink on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> April at 18:00 at the Archery Centre next to the FOP.

On Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> April at 17:30, we will have a good bye drink in the same centre, just after the afternoon award ceremony.

All team captains and team officials are kindly invited.

Transport to hotels will be provided.

**7.2. Medal Ceremonies****Teams :**

Medal ceremonies will be conducted at the conclusion of the team finals sessions on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April after the last match. Teams will receive medals and cups. No bows are allowed on the podium.

**Individuals:**

Medal ceremonies on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> April, for individual finals will be conducted after the last gold medal match in the afternoon.

Athletes will receive medals and flowers and **Price money** (see pt 4.4)

No bows are allowed on the podium.

## **8) Medical Related issues**

A First Aid Services will be available in the Archery Venue, during all the competition. A fully equipped emergency care ambulance with a nurse and a paramedic will be on duty throughout the tournament.

### **8.1. Doping control**

Doping control will follow FITA rules (EMAU GP and World Ranking events, your athletes should bring their passports and accreditation cards to the doping control).

### **8.2. Alcohol test**

According to FITA rules; Levels of alcohol might also be being tested during the competition.

## **9) Dress Instructions**

Athletes, officials and staff should have a smart appearance, when they are on the field.

Athletes and Technicians should wear no other kind of foot wear, than sport- shoes or raining shoes-boots (if raining).

## **10) Other matters of importance**

### **10.1. Accreditation cards:**

The accreditation card must be worn at all times in the practice and competition areas.

Only athletes competing in certain stages of the event are allowed on the Field of play, together with their coaches. Your cooperation in ensuring only the correct athletes are on the Field of Play would be appreciated as it will make a better event for all.

### **10.2. Forms:**

All the forms attached to this TC booklet must be filled in by all the athletes and given to the OC at the accreditation office. (FITA athlete's consent form anti doping, FITA participation waiver & competitor agreement and minority of age forms)

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### Article 3.13.2.1:

An intention to appeal when it might affect the progression of an athlete from one stage of the competition to the next, must be expressed in writing and lodged with the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission and/or the Jury within 5 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first. The written appeal must be lodged with the Jury within 15 minutes of the end of the relevant round or match, whichever comes first, to allow the Jury to come to a decision before the beginning of the next round of the competition.

I also acknowledge and agree that any dispute arising out of a decision made pursuant to the FITA Anti-Doping Rules, after exhaustion of the process expressly provided for in the FITA Anti-Doping Rules, may be appealed exclusively as provided in Article 13 of the FITA Anti-Doping Rules to an appellate body for final and binding arbitration, which in the case of International-Level Athletes is the Court of Arbitration for Sport.
6. I acknowledge and agree that the decisions of the arbitral appellate body referenced above shall be final and enforceable, and that I will not bring any claim, arbitration, lawsuit or litigation in any other court or tribunal.
