In the TM meeting the final numbers will be given.

EC Titles and medals will be given in all categories.

There will be two qualification courses:

1 next to the hotel, the other one below the castle.

The Elimination and Final courses will also all be next to the Hotel, resp below the castle.

Entrance into the courses is only allowed for competitors, judges and field crew.

The TM are not allowed to enter the courses, except in case of emergency and upon request by the Chairman of the Tournament Judge commission in case of equipment failure. Some targets can be viewed from the normal public viewing areas.

No mobile telephones or cameras can be taken by the athletes onto the competition field.

The EC takes place as per the actual WA Rules 1.4.2012, book 2 Events and book 4 3D/Field and we take it for granted that all participants know the new rules!

The Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission will also give his specific information later in this meeting. Pse ask questions if there still remain uncertainties!

The animal targets from the producer SRT (see the Organiser's Website) will be placed as per the group mentioned in the rules:

4-8 targets from each of the above mentioned sized 11/10/8 3D targets are to be used in each course.

As per the rules for small targets, two animal targets will be positioned next to each other.

Accreditation takes place at Trakoscan Hotel

Equipment Inspection will be next to the restaurant below the castle = Central area

Practice field=Warming Up Field: Central area

Opening, Closing and Award Ceremony: Central area Banquett Farewell party – Restaurant: Central area

Team Managers at accreditation please check the correct writing of your athletes' name.

The athletes should have their accreditation cards with them at all times of the competition.

Athlete numbers will most probably be issued after the TM Meeting or be available in the mailboxes Tuesday evening.

If special athlete numbers will be issued for each part of the competition, they will be handed out at the same time as the scoring cards at the pegs in the gathering area.

The target assignment list for the  $1^{st}$  Qualification Round will either be available at or after the TM Meeting in the mail boxes.

Mailboxes are in the hall of Hotel Trakoscan

Those teams with own lodging, please give during Accreditation your TM mobile-number to the LOC.



















Samples of the scorecards will be shown during the TM Meeting.

Scorecards will be handed out at the competition days at the gathering pegs in the central area.

Double scoring has to be done by the athletes.

Before handing the scorecards back to the results office, they should be checked by the group for inclusion of the correct scores, signatures and 11 and 10's. Especially the numbers of 11 and 10 should be totalled as well.

Please note no checking of the scorecards is done by the Results office. When two scorecards do not tally, the lowest score will be taken into the resultlist.

Once the scorecards are in the IANSEO Results office, corrections can no longer be made.

TM please also ask your athletes to wait after the  $2^{nd}$  qualification and  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  elimination rounds for possible shoot offs

The TM must give a change in the names of the athletes in the Team competition latest Thursday 15.00 hrs. In all other cases the teams are automatically composed of the 3 best athletes in the 4 bow classes, as per the results of the 2 qualification rounds (see attached form for a change in teams)

Equipment inspection will be executed on Tuesday, September  $11^{th}$  from 10.00 - 14.00 in the central area. Each team will be called by the Tournament Judge Commission – in english alphabetical order - to the inspection in the central area.

All team members should wear their team uniform; also all spare equipment including binoculars must be brought to the equipment inspection.

TM please check again the correct spelling of your athletes in the startinglists.

### Dress instructions:

Official Teamdresses should be worn at the Opening Ceremony. Also the information in book 4, introduction article, applies to this EC.

For the semi finals and finals - individual and teams - it is required that the name of the athlete and the MAS, is printed on the back of the shirt.

During the competition spare equipment can be stored in a secured tent in the central area. The TM should know where the equipment of their athletes is stored, so that in case of equipment failure a replacement can be found easily and be carried into the field within in the time allowed.

Water will be issued before going into the courses at the area next to the practice field resp. warming up field. Water is also available at course 1 near target nr.... in course 2 near target nr.....



















#### Toilets:

Practice/Warming up field - in the restaurant

There will be one toilet in each course:

Course nr 1 - near target nr...

Course nr 2 - near target nr..

When passing during the competition the restaurant in the central area or the hotel, also the toilets there can be used.

"Lost and Found" place will be in the central area.

TM please ask your athletes to use the litterbags on the courses and not to leave litter in the courses.

#### Medical:

First and Doctor aid is available at the central area

Ambulance/Doctor on call - the same is valid for the Firebrigade.

Hospital somewhat removed from Trakoscan.

## Health-ticks - insects

The OC does not foresee any problems in this area.

It might, however, be handy that your athletes be prepared and bring anti-repellent themselves.

Doping control and alcohol testing

Doping control will follow EMAU and WA Rules.

Also alcohol will be tested.

Opening ceremony takes place next to the restaurant (central area) on Tuesday  $11^{\text{th}}$  of September at 18.00

The teams should gather for marching in at 17.40 at the central area.

A Flagbearer should be designated by the TM.

The flags will be gathered after the marching in. Also the flagbearers can joint their team.

There will be seating possibilities for the teams.

The Opening Ceremony will take approx. 30 minutes.

The EMAU flag will be carried by the 2010 European Champions present at this 3D

Championship, being: Paolo Bucci – Fabio Pittaluga – Giuseppe Seimandi
